# Men's Network current awareness bulletin



This month saw the launch of the Men's' Staff Network at ULHT. To coincide with the launch we have developed a bimonthly current awareness bulletin to support the network and its information needs. A selection of resources included in the first edition can be found below:

The **Men's Health Forum** have been campaigning for a men's health strategy and recently <u>welcomed the decision by MPs to launch an inquiry into men's mental and physical health</u>.

The <u>Movember charity</u> website has lots of information and resources under the **Men's Health section** 

The Fatherhood Institute is conducting <u>a comprehensive review (funded by the Nuffield Trust) of decades of research into the roles and impacts of UK fathers in families</u>. Six reports have been published since 2017.

The <u>most recent issue of the East Genomics newsletter</u> presents a prostate cancer project seeking to tackle health inequalities for men of African / African Caribbean heritage who are twice as likely to develop prostate cancer than white men.
