## Library services during the pandemic

You may have noticed that some of our library services (and libraries!) have changed in recent months. The Covid-19 pandemic has affected our ability to provide a full library service but we are endeavouring to find new ways of working and of supporting Trust staff.

The library at Lincoln County Hospital was converted into a clinical space in March 2020. Sadly, this meant the loss of a study space, computers, and our book and journal collections. We are working hard to provide a new library for staff at Lincoln and we'll bring you any updates as soon as we can. We have also been unable to provide an on-site library service at Grantham due to its green site status. Once we can be on-site again regularly we will let you know.

In more positive news the library at Pilgrim Hospital, Boston is now back up and running and is staffed **Monday 9-3, Wednesday 9-3 and Thursday 11-3**. 24 hour access is also available.

We are still able to provide the majority of our services as normal (such as article requests and literature searches) but there have been some changes. For example, training sessions will now be via Microsoft Teams and book loans are available as we can post these to your work address.
