<p>Child Abuse: straight to the point of care <i>Child abuse (including neglect) is any form of maltreatment of a child, either by inflicting harm or by failing to act to prevent harm. Children may be abused in a family, institutional, or community setting, by those close to them, such as a parent or caregiver or, more rarely, by a stranger. They may be abused by adults or by other children. There are 4 categories of child abuse: physical abuse, emotional abuse (also called psychological maltreatment), sexual abuse, and neglect. This monograph primarily addresses physical child abuse.
