I was 18 years old and sitting across the desk from a psychiatry resident who said to me, "Miss Deegan, you have a disease called schizophrenia. Schizophrenia is a disease that is a lot like diabetes. Just like a diabetic has to take insulin for the rest of their lives, you'll have to take antipsychotic medication for the rest of your life." He proceeded to tell me that after discharge, my job was to avoid stress and take high dose antipsychotics religiously, in order to slow the progression of the disease. No romance. No school. Just avoid stress. No one at the time told me boredom and meaninglessness are profoundly stressful.
