Intolerance of uncertainty as a factor of hoarding treatment <i>Hoarding disorder (HD) involves difficulty discarding clutter. Existing treatments for HD (including cognitive-behavioral therapy [CBT]) yield only partial symptom reduction. Identifying factors that contribute to hoarding may inform potential treatment mechanisms. One such factor is intolerance of uncertainty (IU), the tendency to maladaptively respond to the unknown via fear, discomfort, and avoidance.
