When night falls fast

Sleep disturbances, including insomnia and nightmares, are associated with suicidal behaviors in youth and predictive of future suicidal ideation. Data regarding hypersomnia, sleep apnea, and suicide risk in youth are mixed. Interconnected biological and psychological mechanisms may underlie the relationship between sleep and suicidal behaviors: executive functioning, hyperarousal, thwarted belongingness, and perceived burdensomeness, among others.
