


Oxford University Press eBooks

Within the Oxford University Press eBook collection NHS Staff have access to the Oxford Handbooks and Oxford Textbooks range of titles.


Go to: <https://academic.oup.com/books>

Then select it from the drop down menu.




Then sign in with your NHS OpenAthens username and password.

If you do not have a NHS OpenAthens account then you can self-register for one here: <https://openathens.nice.org.uk/>


To find the full list of titles available select **Advanced Search** next to the search box in the blue bar at the top of the page.

Then select **Purchased** (in the *Availability* section)




Then click on the title of the book you wish to view from the results list e.g. **Oxford Handbook of Urology**.


Individual Titles
